Holy Saturday At the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night of Easter (Easter Vigil)

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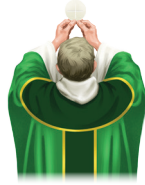
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◇ The highest point of the liturgical year is the

Epistle

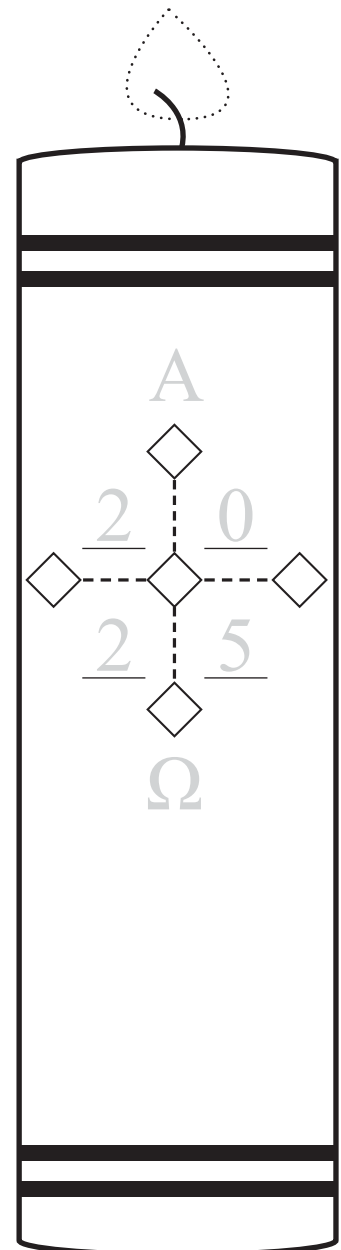
from St. Paul's Letter to the

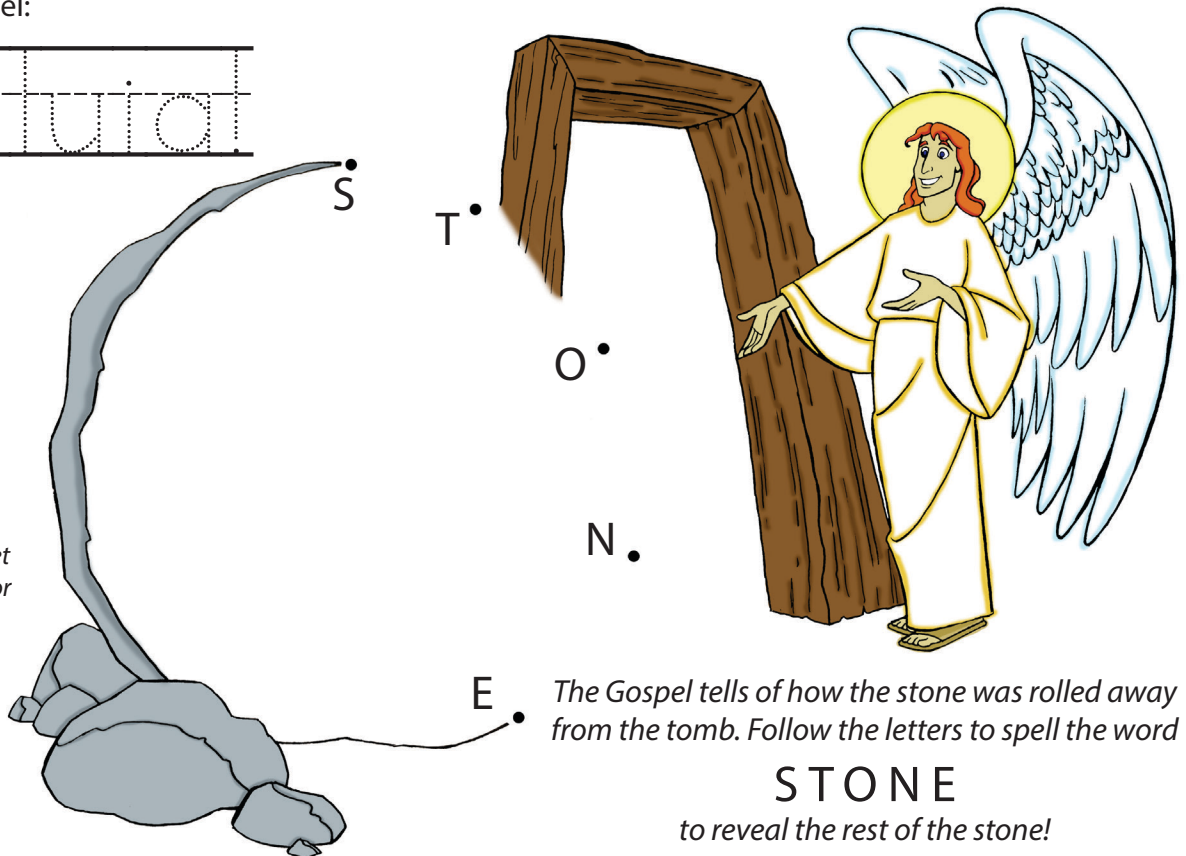
