**A Message from our Pastor
Msgr. Bob Cilinski**



“If you knew the gift of God, and who is saying to you ‘give me a drink’ you would have asked him and he would give you living water.” ~ John 4:10

My dear parishioners,

Reflection: When the Israelites passed through the waters of the sea into freedom, they were saved from slavery. Even so, they grumbled against Moses, harshly criticizing him for leading them into the wilderness to die. Despite their complaints, God was faithful. At the Lord’s command, Moses struck a rock and water issued forth.

Jesus described God’s life-giving presence with the image of a *“fountain springing up from within.”* He offered this gift to a nameless woman who represents all God’s people whose lives are as dry as a stagnant cistern.

Jesus reveals our inner need for the living water of the Spirit. With the Elect preparing for baptism, we repent of our own thirst for power, prestige, or possessions. Whatever blocks the love of God from being poured into our hearts must be uncovered and healed. Then we can drink deeply from the life-giving springs of grace.

For Reflection: What do I need from God to satisfy my spiritual thirst? Am I aware that I am walking with the elect on their journey of faith this Lent?

We rejoice with our Elect and Candidates in our parish who will receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. We journey together from the desert to the fountain of new life that Jesus brings to us and pray for one another.

Finding Jesus in Holy Communion
with Fr. John Riley**

All are invited to participate in our 2026 Lenten Parish Mission: “In Christ we are One.” This year’s Parish Mission is scheduled for March 9, 10 and 11.

Our Holy Father Pope Leo’s motto is *“In the One, We are One”*. It is God’s Plan that we seek and find Our Lord with others, with our family, with our parish, and as members of our *“One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church”*. In our conferences we will consider insights from Pope Leo XIV, the genius of St. Augustine, and the words of Jesus in His *“Farewell Discourse”* in the Gospel of St. John. Join us in this week’s Parish Mission as we quietly read and think and pray with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and consider how, though we are many, we can truly be one with each other... and with Christ.

Fr. John Riley will celebrate Mass and lecture in the mornings, and evenings (see schedule below). The Mission will conclude with Mass on Wednesday, March 11 at 7:00 pm. *(Adoration on Wednesday evening will be from 5:00 to 6:30pm)*

Father John Riley has been a priest for over 30 years, serving in the Arlington Diocese, in Denver, and beyond. He has taught and led hundreds of conferences, missions, and retreats for priests, religious sisters, and laity around the country and as far afield as Calcutta, India. His first love is helping people seek and find Jesus Christ by treasuring and pondering the Gospels in deep quiet prayer. Fr. Riley currently serves as Spiritual Director for the Arlington Diocese’s San Damiano Retreat Center in White Post, VA.





Arlington bishop joins Pope Leo, US bishops in appeal for peace after Iran strikes.

Bishop Michael Burbidge of Arlington, Virginia, issued a statement March 2 calling for prayers for a swift end to escalating U.S.-Israeli military strikes against Iran, urging the faithful and “people of goodwill” to seek “genuine and lasting peace” in the Middle East and beyond.

“As U.S.-Israeli strikes against the Iranian regime unfold, I invite all the faithful and people of goodwill to pray for a swift conclusion to hostilities,” Bishop Burbidge stated. “The Church reminds us that true peace is a reflection of Christ’s peace, and in this life is a work of justice and fruit of charity. EL POZO QUE, TODOS, TENEMOS 3º de cuaresma (A) Javier Leoz

Nos preocupa, sobre todo en España, la escasez de agua. Miramos hacia el cielo deseando que, el Señor, la envíe abundantemente porque, sin ella, es difícil vivir y, sin ella, todo –personas, animales y valles- se resecan.

1. Lo mismo que la tierra tiene sed, algo parecido le ocurrió a Jesús. Estaba cansado, sediento y...pedía agua. Al borde de un pozo, la Samaritana, quería quedarse en lo superficial (que también es importante) pero Jesús le ofrece otro agua que es surtidor de paz y de vida interior, de felicidad y de dicha.

¿Dónde tienes tú el cántaro? Respondería la Samaritana. Decía, reclamaba y hacía como tantas veces, lo hacemos nosotros cuando ponemos trabas e inconvenientes a Dios para que El no actúe en nuestras vidas. ¿De qué estamos sedientos? ¿Del agua cristalina y fresca? ¿O de algo más? El mundo, los hombres y mujeres de nuestro tiempo, están/estamos saturados de todo y, a la vez, de nada. Sentimos que no nos falta lo necesario para vivir y, en un sentimiento encontrado, percibimos que nos falta siempre un “algo” para ser felices. Es entonces cuando, Jesús, entra en acción. No nos ofrece el agua embotellada o etiquetada que el negocio nos vende. Jesús, consciente de la sed del hombre, esa sed que no es apagada por la frescura del agua corriente, nos lleva a una fuente que calma nuestra ansiedad y sed de Dios. Entre otras cosas, sentarse junto al pozo de Jesús, implica –además- sentarse frente a la verdad de uno mismo. Y, esto, ¡cuánto nos cuesta!

2. Todos, también los que estamos preparándonos a los días santos de la Pascua, tenemos un pozo donde y en el que encontrarnos con el Señor.

. El pozo de la oración. En él, el Señor, nos moldea y nos habla. Es un pozo en el que, el corazón que busca a Dios, se abre de tal manera, que el Espíritu obra maravillas en él.

. El pozo de la Eucaristía. Cuando nos acercamos a ella sentimos que, además de mitigar la sed, el Señor nos alimenta y fortalece para seguir batallando en la vida.

. El pozo de la Palabra. Al acercarnos al pozo de la Palabra sentimos que el Señor nos interpela con la misma fuerza que a la Samaritana. Parece como si, ésta o aquella Palabra, estuviera expresamente indicada, dicha y diseñada para cada uno de nosotros. Como si Dios, al igual que lo obró en la misma Samaritana, tuviera especial interés en despertar nuestra sed por El y para El.

. El pozo de la Iglesia. Muchos hermanos nuestros, amigos y conocidos, prefieren buscarse sus propias fuentes para creer y esperar. Pero ¿Quién nos ha dado de beber, con pasión de madre y gratuitamente, el agua del Evangelio, del amor de Dios o de los sacramentos que incentiva y da vida a nuestra fe? El pozo de la Iglesia. En él nos sentamos para escuchar la Palabra; para ponernos en paz con Dios por el sacramento de la reconciliación; para recibir el pan de la Eucaristía o para compartir, lo mucho o lo poco que tenemos, con los más necesitados.

Frente a un mundo hambriento y sediento de lo superfluo, la Samaritana, representa esa parte interior, que todos nosotros poseemos, y que está llamada a despertar, cuidarse y descubrirse por el encuentro personal con Jesús.

Está bien que, como necesitados del agua natural, la pidamos a Dios pero, de igual manera, miremos un poco más allá; profundicemos bajo las aguas del simple pozo de nuestra existencia y...busquemos ese Espíritu que nos puede dar vida y tonificar totalmente, de arriba abajo, lo que somos, pensamos y realizamos.




