My dear parishioners,

Last Sunday Fr. Sean Mazary returned to Nativity to celebrate a "First Mass" with us. We journeyed together during his deacon year and rejoiced with him as he was ordained to the priesthood. He said in his "second homily" how grateful he was for the loving Nativity Community that surrounded him this past year.

Now we welcome seminarian Gabriel Gaudet to Nativity for his deacon year. He will be with us during the summer and then on weekends as he completes his studies at Mount St. Mary's Seminary. 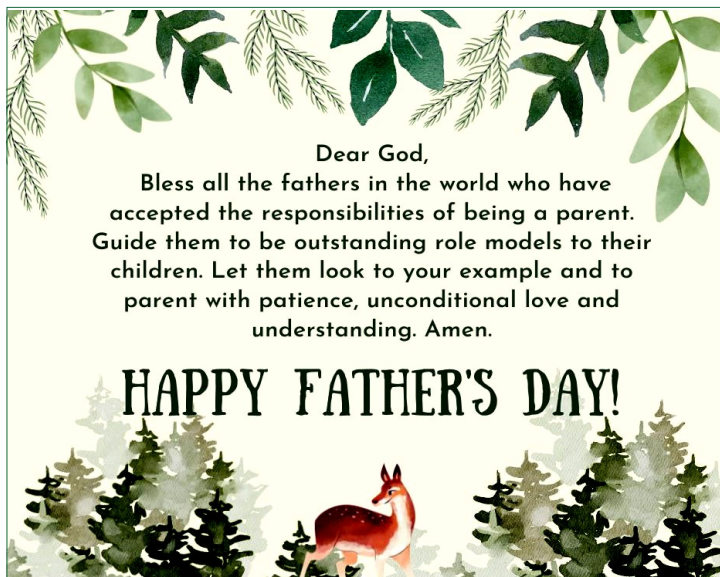

The ministry uses two-person teams to cover each of the seven weekend Masses so every Mass has a watchful, supportive presence. We seek mature Catholics who stay calm under pressure, are physically able, and value humility, teamwork, and service. Anyone committed to helping protect our community is welcome.

Volunteers will participate in regular security training, including the next CPR/AED/First Aid certification class on July 18, attend quarterly team meetings, and serve on a rotating schedule. During assigned Masses, team members will patrol the church, stay alert for safety concerns, and work together to maintain a secure worship environment. APPALACHIA HOME BUILDING: "THANK YOU NATIVITY"



On behalf of the Knights of Columbus, the Appalachian Construction Crew of Omaha, NE, and the Mitchell family of three, we want to thank the Nativity family for their tremendous outpouring of support that made this home building effort possible. With the combined donations from Nativity, the Knights, and personal donations, our contributions totaled over \$140,000, not including a truck load of household items provided by the Nativity family. As part of the contributions, Nativity has also sent \$45,000 for the Outreach Program to help other county residents. With slightly over \$10,000 raised from Omaha, the combined crews were able to again build a home for a very needy family.

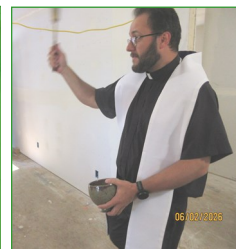
Good Shepherd Catholic Chapel selected the Mitchell family who clearly had some challenges. The family lived in a dilapidated trailer that had to be demolished to make way for the new home. This was the 28th home where Nativity and the Knights partnered with the Appalachian Construction Crew.

From May 27th to June 8th, the combined crews were able to complete the home with two of those days dedicated to travel. The Nativity crew totaled 22 knights; Omaha sponsored 7 that included a support crew to help with feeding the Crew. Weather was challenging with hotter temperatures and little rain. Notwithstanding the weather, with the larger crew, we were able to finish the home a day earlier. Local electrical, heating/air conditioning, and plumbing contractors worked at night to ensure the home was ready for critical inspections. Early Tuesday, we completed hanging all the sheetrock and applied the first coat on most of the joints and cleaned up the site for the house blessing. Literally, we completed all this work, exterior construction and interior rough-in, in 5½ days. We had the house blessing on Tuesday afternoon led by Father Ben Horn. That night we had the family over for dinner with the entire crew and presented the grandmother, Patricia, with the keys to her new home. We also told them of all the household items that we brought from Nativity from the Christmas giving tree, in addition to the new beds we provided for all the family. The family was overwhelmed with the outpouring of help and the caring from the Nativity family. Patricia was in tears and thanked everyone.

On Wednesday morning, the first crew departed, and the finishing crew took over. From Wednesday through Sunday, our Nativity finishing crew of eight, with Omaha's three, stayed to do all the finishing. The finishing team completed all the drywall finishing, painting, hanging doors, trimming, and installing kitchen cabinets. The finishing crew left on Monday. All final inspections were completed by June 18th, and appliances and new beds provided by Nativity will be delivered soon after. The family will move in before the end of June.

In addition, we were told how our outreach efforts were making a difference with wheelchair ramps, hygiene kits for over 200 kids, assistance with offsetting medical and utility bills, and with food assistance at five schools for the poorest children to have food over the weekend.

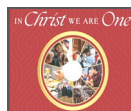



This effort to educate and engage the faithful seeks to ensure that every Catholic understands that there are two dangerous amendments to the Virginia Constitution before the voters this fall. This fall in the Commonwealth of Virginia two proposed amendments on the ballot threaten the human right to life and the truth of marriage. These proposed amendments are called the “Virginia Right to Reproductive Freedom Amendment” and the “Virginia Remove Constitutional Same-Sex Marriage Ban Amendment.” They also threaten constitutional justice, the equal protection of the laws, and religious liberty.

As Catholics, we vote “no” on these proposed amendments. We recognize that, if passed, these amendments would enshrine objective wrongs in Virginia’s Constitution and overturn basic matters of justice and gravely damage the intrinsic dignity of persons and the nature of marriage and the family. These are matters of fundamental truth concerning the human person.

Although Catholics may in good conscience disagree over most political policies which call for strictly prudential judgments, certain fundamental matters such as marriage and the protection of human life demand a consistent and universal response from Catholics to protect and preserve objective goods by which God blesses humanity.

If written into Virginia’s Constitution, these unjust amendments would be extraordinarily difficult to reverse. Virginia would effectively become a sanctuary for abortion and commercial abortion businesses. Basic health and safety standards that protect women from harm would be eliminated, parents would be pushed out of life-altering decisions involving their family and children, and unregulated abortions would be possible, performed even on healthy babies up to the moment of birth for any reason with no limits.

At the same time, Virginia's Constitution would mislead future generations concerning the truth about marriage by adopting a false legal definition of marriage that would further erode a public sense of marriage as a natural institution uniting one man and one woman. Additionally, the amendment would lead to the expansion of an already existing commercial surrogacy industry which violates the natural rights of children and exploits vulnerable mothers.” <https://www.arlingtondiocese.org/vote>.
