The Nativity Security Ministry is inviting parishioners to help keep our church safe and welcoming.

The ministry uses two-person teams to cover each of the seven weekend Masses so every Mass has a watchful, supportive presence. We seek mature Catholics who stay calm under pressure, are physically able, and value humility, teamwork, and service. Anyone committed to helping protect our community is welcome.

Volunteers will participate in regular security training, including the next CPR/AED/First Aid certification class on July 18, attend quarterly team meetings, and serve on a rotating schedule. During assigned Masses, team members will patrol the church, stay alert for safety concerns, and work together to maintain a secure worship environment. APPALACHIA HOME BUILDING: "THANK YOU NATIVITY"



On behalf of the Knights of Columbus, the Appalachian Construction Crew of Omaha, NE, and the Mitchell family of three, we want to thank the Nativity family for their tremendous outpouring of support that made this home building effort possible. With the combined donations from Nativity, the Knights, and personal donations, our contributions totaled over \$140,000, not including a truck load of household items provided by the Nativity family. As part of the contributions, Nativity has also sent \$45,000 for the Outreach Program to help other county residents. With slightly over \$10,000 raised from Omaha, the combined crews were able to again build a home for a very needy family.

Good Shepherd Catholic Chapel selected the Mitchell family who clearly had some challenges. The family lived in a dilapidated trailer that had to be demolished to make way for the new home. This was the 28th home where Nativity and the Knights partnered with the Appalachian Construction Crew.

From May 27th to June 8th, the combined crews were able to complete the home with two of those days dedicated to travel. The Nativity crew totaled 22 knights; Omaha sponsored 7 that included a support crew to help with feeding the Crew. Weather was challenging with hotter temperatures and little rain. Notwithstanding the weather, with the larger crew, we were able to finish the home a day earlier. Local electrical, heating/air conditioning, and plumbing contractors worked at night to ensure the home was ready for critical inspections. Early Tuesday, we completed hanging all the sheetrock and applied the first coat on most of the joints and cleaned up the site for the house blessing. Literally, we completed all this work, exterior construction and interior rough-in, in 5½ days. We had the house blessing on Tuesday afternoon led by Father Ben Horn. That night we had the family over for dinner with the entire crew and presented the grandmother, Patricia, with the keys to her new home. We also told them of all the household items that we brought from Nativity from the Christmas giving tree, in addition to the new beds we provided for all the family. The family was overwhelmed with the outpouring of help and the caring from the Nativity family. Patricia was in tears and thanked everyone.

On Wednesday morning, the first crew departed, and the finishing crew took over. From Wednesday through Sunday, our Nativity finishing crew of eight, with Omaha's three, stayed to do all the finishing. The finishing team completed all the drywall finishing, painting, hanging doors, trimming, and installing kitchen cabinets. The finishing crew left on Monday. All final inspections were completed by June 18th, and appliances and new beds provided by Nativity will be delivered soon after. The family will move in before the end of June.

In addition, we were told how our outreach efforts were making a difference with wheelchair ramps, hygiene kits for over 200 kids, assistance with offsetting medical and utility bills, and with food assistance at five schools for the poorest children to have food over the weekend.

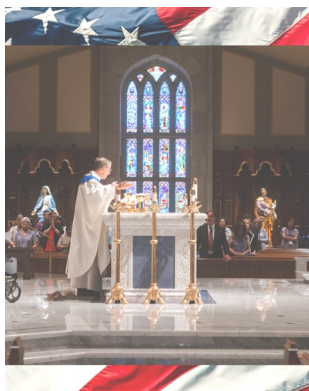
A message from Nativity Creation Care Ministry

Each summer, many faith communities participate in Plastic-Free July, a month-long challenge to reduce our use of plastics and to examine the amount of plastic we use in our day-to-day life. (learn more at plasticfreejuly.org)

We can start by reducing our use of "The Big Four":

1. Say no to single-use plastic straws
2. Bring your reusable bags to the grocery store. Don't forget the produce bags too! (Most produce doesn't even need a bag. Leave it naked.)
3. Bring a full water bottle with you before you leave your house. Phone, wallet, WATER, keys – good to go.
4. Say no to "to-go" coffee cups by bringing your own or asking for the coffee to stay in a real mug.

ECHO Collection next weekend, July 4/5 Food Room Most Needed

Thank you for including ECHO Food Room needs on your shopping list. The USDA calculates that a meal for one persons is considered to be 1.2 pounds of food. Thus far this fiscal year ECHO has distributed 288,560 pounds of food which converts to 240,466 meals given to our neighbors in Burke and Springfield. Thank you donors for your generosity in helping our neighbors. Your help is greatly appreciated. With all of the charitable donations the weekend of June 6/7, we still collected 794 lbs of food. What a generous parish we have!!

ECHO 's policy is to not give expired, open or repackaged food to clients. PLEASE do not bring these items or glass jars!!

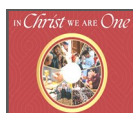

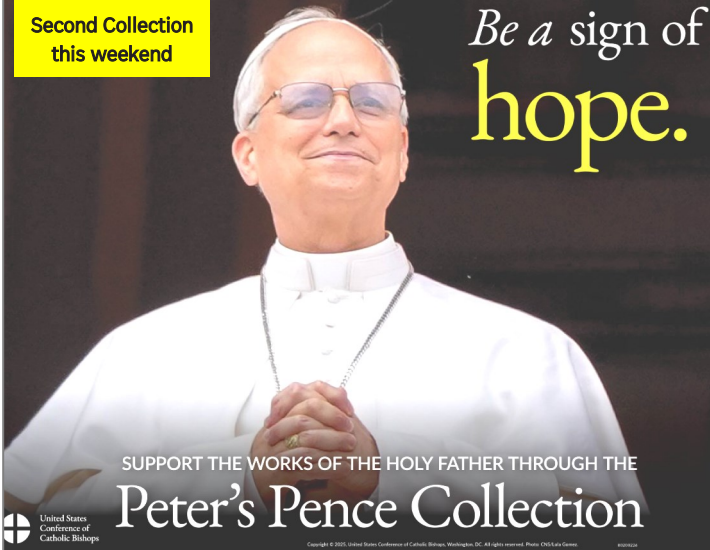

PRO-LIFE CORNER

Defending those with Intellectual Disabilities

Jérôme Lejeune – Famous Geneticist, Devout Catholic and Sanctity of Life Advocate

“A century after his birth, French geneticist Jérôme Lejeune is being remembered for both a landmark scientific discovery and a steadfast commitment to the dignity of human life. Born June 13, 1926, near Paris, Lejeune identified in 1958 that an extra chromosome 21 causes Down syndrome, a breakthrough that transformed modern genetics. He believed that would help protect and care for vulnerable children. Instead, he lived to see it widely used for prenatal screening that often led to Down syndrome babies’ elimination. A devout Catholic, he later served in the Pontifical Academy of Sciences and became the first president of the Pontifical Academy for Life, founded by St. John Paul II in 1994... He was deeply saddened to see that his discovery would be used to detect Down syndrome before birth and to eliminate those who carried it. His concern was to change society’s negative view of them and to advance research to find ways to treat them... He embodied a holiness grounded in intelligence and his entire life was guided by his search for truth... His primary concern was to anchor the truth in charity. One cannot understand Jérôme Lejeune without mercy.”

In the spirit of Lejeune’s mission, Word on Fire’s *Fellowship for Persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities* works to draw these individuals and their families more deeply into the life of the Church. 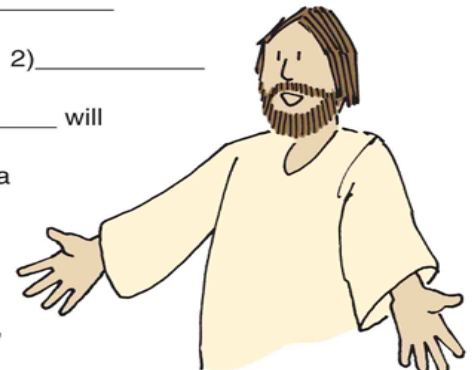

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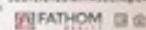
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
