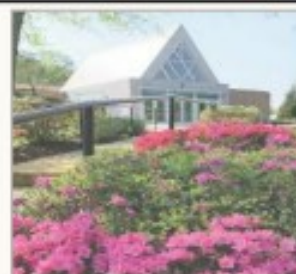

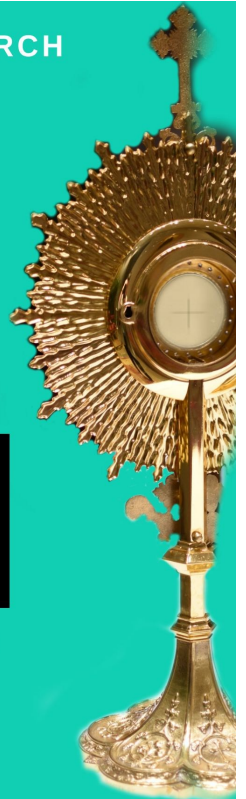

A Message from the Nativity Creation Care Ministry

One of God's most fascinating creatures is the firefly! When they start their early summer dance, will they pick your yard for their display? Like most insects, firefly numbers are in a steep decline, but there are steps we can take to foster them on our properties. Taking those steps has far-reaching benefits even beyond the joy of having our own private light shows. What we do to create habitat for fireflies can go a long way toward restoring life to our yards in general.

The first step in creating usable habitat is to plant (and preserve) native plants and trees and to remove invasive non-native plants. This is because most plant-eating insects can only eat the plants with which they evolved. Fireflies don't eat plants, though, so how does this apply? The answer lies in the food web concept. Predatory insects such as fireflies, dragonflies, ladybugs, etc, eat the critters that eat the native plants. The next step is to provide shelter and breeding sites by leaving dead leaves in place and devoting as much of your yard as you can to natural landscaping. The third step is reducing outdoor lighting. If fireflies can't see potential mates blinking, they won't be able to get together. Light pollution has negative impacts on many other beings as well including migrating birds. The final step is critical: avoid the use of insecticides outdoors. Insecticides (such as sprays for adult mosquitoes) kill all insects, including fireflies, bees, butterflies, crickets, etc, and totally upset the natural balance between predators and prey that is necessary for a healthy garden and ecosystem. Instead, google the "mosquito bucket challenge"! Bring back the thrill of one of the wonders of God's creation—the firefly!

Thank you for including ECHO Food Room needs on your shopping list. The USDA calculates that a meal for one persons is considered to be 1.2 pounds of food. Thus far this fiscal year ECHO has distributed 288,560 pounds of food which converts to 240,466 meals given to our neighbors in Burke and Springfield. Thank you donors for your generosity in helping our neighbors. Your help is greatly appreciated. We collected 970 lbs on the weekend of May/2/3, 2026.

ECHO 's policy is to not give expired, open or repackaged food to clients. PLEASE do not bring these items or glass jars!!

This effort to educate and engage the faithful seeks to ensure that every Catholic understands that there are two dangerous amendments to the Virginia Constitution before the voters this fall. Catholics must vote and must reject them both. Listen to Bishop Burbidge explain why on his latest podcast: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=P7fVuO7Fbkg&t=966s>

This fall in the Commonwealth of Virginia two proposed amendments on the ballot threaten the human right to life and the truth of marriage. These proposed amendments are called the “Virginia Right to Reproductive Freedom Amendment” and the “Virginia Remove Constitutional Same-Sex Marriage Ban Amendment.” They also threaten constitutional justice, the equal protection of the laws, and religious liberty.

As Catholics, we vote “no” on these proposed amendments. We recognize that, if passed, these amendments would enshrine objective wrongs in Virginia’s Constitution and overturn basic matters of justice and gravely damage the intrinsic dignity of persons and the nature of marriage and the family. These are matters of fundamental truth concerning the human person. Although Catholics may in good conscience disagree over most political policies which call for strictly prudential judgments, certain fundamental matters such as marriage and the protection of human life demand a consistent and universal response from Catholics to protect and preserve objective goods by which God blesses humanity.

If written into Virginia’s Constitution, these unjust amendments would be extraordinarily difficult to reverse. Virginia would effectively become a sanctuary for abortion and commercial abortion businesses. Basic health and safety standards that protect women from harm would be eliminated, parents would be pushed out of life-altering decisions involving their family and children, and unregulated abortions would be possible, performed even on healthy babies up to the moment of birth for any reason with no limits.

At the same time, Virginia’s Constitution would mislead future generations concerning the truth about marriage by adopting a false legal definition of marriage that would further erode a public sense of marriage as a natural institution uniting one man and one woman. Additionally, the amendment would lead to the expansion of an already existing commercial surrogacy industry which violates the natural rights of children and exploits vulnerable mothers.” <https://www.arlingtondiocese.org/vote>

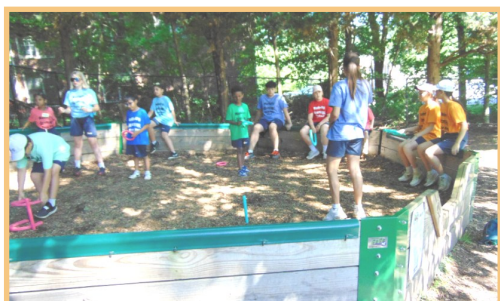
Students Leveling the Playing Field

Todavía se sostienen en el aire las palabras de Jesús en Jueves Santo: “tomad y comed; tomad y bebed”. ¡Por supuesto que no! Pero que, ello, no sea justificación para no poner en el centro de este domingo –radiante y espléndido– lo que es vida en nuestra muerte, fuerza en nuestra debilidad, recuperación en nuestro hastío, ilusión en nuestro desencanto, generosidad en nuestra tacañería: LA EUCARISTIA.

2. El amor de Jesús que fue impresionantemente volcado, a los ojos de los apóstoles en aquel primer Jueves Santo, se derrama, se desparrama un año más en una inmensa patena, en un gigantesco cáliz a través de las calles y plazas.
